# NCIP update (Jean and Hans)

- March 17, 2022 next meeting to discuss the approximately 120 projects that were de-funded over the last 10 years, and about 70 projects from 2020 that were put on "pause", as well as some new projects
- City has released \$3 million from last years budget and projections for next year is over \$4 million due to boost from the TOT hotel tax
- Difficulty in maintaining City engineers, slow movement of projects,
  - High cost of living and salary levels an issue
- Projects that are intact and considered viable will go back into the pool to be evaluated

# Undergrounding Report (Ray)

- Focused meeting on ballot measure for a utility users tax increase
- City unable to help with ballot deadline
- Resources needed and time frame needed for 1100 signatures to get the ballot measure together effectively
- Decision to wait until next election cycle
- Need for an extensive survey and broaden audience by bringing up issues relating to the sustainability of our electric grid
- Drafted outline of survey, webpage for arguments pro/con and ask people how they feel about undergrounding, request neighborhood associations send out survey
- Mayor Clyde thought it would be a daunting task to get the votes needed this cycle but discussed global warming impacts perhaps tie in undergrounding to a "green" future for Monterey
- Possibility of changing priorities of over \$4 million in unused credits to areas of high fire zone
- Hoffa suggestion to align with CCE energy, sustainability issues
- Discussion ensued
- Use the Monterey Undergrounding website as a resource, need articles for a FAQ page
