With relatively little vacant land available for new development and the risk of environmental hazards like wildfire and flooding in certain locations, accommodating new housing will require a thoughtful strategy. We need to hear from you to make sure the strategy reflects the priorities of our community.

Please take this survey to help plan where new housing, employment, and shopping should be located and how to achieve other community objectives like improving transportation options, revitalizing older commercial streets, and preserving and enhancing neighborhood character. The survey can be completed in just five minutes, but there are options to provide more input and dive deeper into the issues if you wish.
