- Sign for MVNA Picnic, perhaps need to have a banner made for future

Underground committee (Ray and Bruce)

- NCIP funding Monroe Street or a conduit program
- Harris Associates meeting, conservative ideas regarding conduit program, indicated the project is better served by combining projects, thoughts about engineering could change but was unable to state what those were to Ray
- \$450,000 could be applied to conduit program
- Never enough time to get PG&E to move on Monroe Street, suggestion to go for a project at a different location with more lead time
- Use the money to show that the "poles are coming down"
- Are there models for Master Plans for conversion? Eg. Coronado, samples of processes to follow
- Finalized to include local energy resources as part of overall strategy for undergrounding
- New Monterey requested outreach seminar for Neighborhood, presentation about undergrounding, share of information
- 600' recommended minimum for an assessment district, streets need to be restructured combine Measure S project with undergrounding, 30% financial savings
- Encourage involvement in an assessment district for the public to see the benefits of a completed job and get the poles down
- Sustainability, resiliency, and possible incentives within Monterey to move ideas forward
- Difficult to run conduit under sidewalks, need to service both sides of the street with laterals
- Nexus between undergrounding and safety, possible fire hazard areas
